RE: NOTICE TO CEASE & DESIST LOBBYING ACTIVITIES FOR FAILURE TO FILE A LOBBYIST'S PRINCIPAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

Dear Mr. Danzell:

As of today, the State Ethics Commission has not received the Lobbyist's Principal Disclosure Statement for the June 30, 2011 and January 31, 2012 reporting periods or the letter of extenuating circumstances. This letter is to advise you that therefore, you are prohibited from engaging in lobbying activities if you are currently registered as a Lobbyist's Principal in this calendar year and are prohibited from registering to lobby in South Carolina until such time as the forms are received.

A copy of this letter is being sent to each of your lobbyists engaged to lobby for your company to inform them that they have been precluded from all lobbying activities for your company.

If the Lobbyist's Principal Disclosure Statements are not received within ten days of receipt of this letter, additional penalties of \$10 per day per form for the first ten days and \$100 per day per form for each additional day up to a maximum of \$5,000 per form will be levied, and a complaint will be filed against you.

In accordance with Section 2-17-130(A) of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended, a lobbyist or a lobbyist's principal who wilfully violates the provisions of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, must be fined not more than two thousand five hundred dollars or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both. In addition, any lobbyist or lobbyist's principal convicted of or pleading guilty or nolo contendere to a misdemeanor under the provisions of this section is barred from acting as a lobbyist or a lobbyist's principal for a period of three years from the date of the conviction.
